## Take a closer look...

Subject Coverage				
Literacy	We will be starting the term using the story, 'Why Brolgas Dance'. This will allow us to widen our vocabulary, develop our descriptive language and speech dialogue.			
Maths	We will be continuing to work on number knowledge focussing on multiplication and division.			
Science	Science this term will involve reviewing animals groups and learning all about the unique animals that are indigenous to Australia. We will also research some of the unusual adaptions that allow animals and plants to survive in the hot climate.			
History/ Geography	In history we will be finding out who Captain Cook was and how he impacted on finding Australia. In Geography, we will find Australia on a map and will be able to explain where it is in relation to other countries.			
Computing	Pupils will be able to use Pic Collage to combine images of natural and human features that can be found in Australia. We will also be using Tellagami to create our Australian weather reports.			
Art/DT	Pupils will be able to understand the key features of Aboriginal Art and will be able to explain that this unique art comes from a different culture.			
Music	This term we will be using the online learning platform—Charanga—learning to sing the song 'Zoo time' by Joanna Mangona.			
R.E.	This term we will be focusing on Christianity and learning about special places. We will investigate features of churches and learn why churches are special places for Christians.			
Forest School	Children will make woodland creatures using natural resources and find pictures of baby animals matching them to their mother. At the end of term, pupils will celebrate with a forest school version of an Australian BBQ with snags.			
SMSC	We will deliver circle time weekly using the Family Links guide however circle time will also be used to meet the children's needs as and when they arise.
