Take a closer look...

Subject Coverage				
Literacy	We will start the term by looking at poetry. We will discuss the meaning of words and phrases and we will talk about why we like specific words. We will recite poems aloud with intonation and we will use the structure of given poems to help us to write our own. We will then look at recount writing. We will be using extracts from Samuel Pepys diary to model this. In addition to our written work we will continue to do reading, spelling and handwriting daily. We will also be focussing on the meaning of grammatical terms: verb, noun, adjective and adverb.			
Maths	We will be continuing to work on number knowledge. The children should be able to count beyond 100 and they should be able to record these numbers as numerals and words. We will be using money to develop our maths skills and we will then be looking at shapes and weight.			
Science	Science this term will involve learning the names of different materials, finding out their properties and identifying why their properties make them suitable for a particular purpose. They will then carry out an investigation to test the properties of different materials for a specific purpose.			
History/ Geography	This term we will be looking at significant events and people in the distant past. We will be starting by finding out about Guy Fawkes and we will then look at The Great Fire of London. The children will use different sources of information to find out where, why and when the fire happened. They will sequence events of the fire and explain the impact of the fire. Through this topic the children will learn about how people lived in the past.			
Computing	During computing sessions this term we will continue to learn how to be safe when using the internet. We will also use and app called 'Morpho' to present information in a creative way.			
Art/DT	We will be using drawing and observation skills to record images of the Tudor houses which were seen at the time of The Great fire. We will be looking at the style and pattern on the houses and will then investigate cold and warm colours before using collage techniques to present our images.			
Music	We will be learning and performing Christmas songs this term.			
R.E.	This term we will be learning about gifts. We will look at gives that can be given physically and those that we give in other ways. We will learn about the 3 wise men and the symbol of the gifts that they gave.			
P.E.	This term the children will be doing dance for sport. This is taught by Mr Townsend. The will be focussing on agility, balance and coordination.			
SMSC	We will deliver circle time weekly using the Family Links guide however circle time will also be used to meet the children's needs as and when they arise.
