We are ensuring that our communication with you is easier, quicker and more efficient. I am pleased to inform you that we have introduced a new app service to the school.

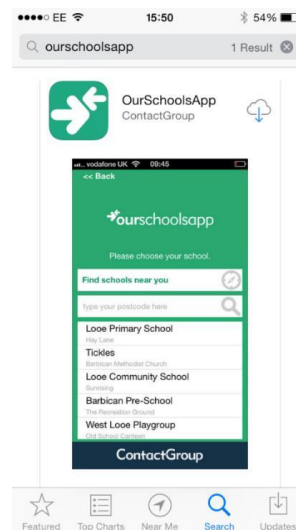
OurSchoolsApp is a personalised app for our school and will allow us to keep you updated with school information, news, calendar events and contact information and much more.

If you have a smartphone (Android or iPhone) you can download OurSchoolsApp from Google Play Android or the Apple Store for FREE. Access is also available on a tablet and iPad by following the same download process.

When we update OurSchoolsApp with new information or news about the school, a push message notification will automatically be sent to your device to inform you of this update. You can then view the notification which will then take you directly to our app.

Instructions for download:

1. Using your device (iPad, iPhone, smart pad, tablet or android phone), visit the relevant marketplace for your product (Apple Store or Google Play).
 2. Search for '**OurSchoolsApp**' and download the app.
 3. Once downloaded, use the search bar within the app and enter the postcode or the name of the school.
 4. Hit the search button.
 5. Once you see the school name displayed, just touch the screen on the school name.
 6. Confirm your choice by pressing 'OK'.
 7. You will now be presented with the correct app for your chosen school which contains news, information, calendar events, contacts and any other relevant details.

There are many young carers in our community and as a school we want to support these children, to achieve their full potential whatever their home circumstances maybe. Some of the ways we do this is provide flexible support for families, signposting to appropriate agencies if required and support for homework. We also have a Young Carers Group called 'Allstars' they meet at least once a term as well as having access to the lunch time nurture club allowing the children a space to talk and have fun activities. Young Carers: Who are they? What do they do?



Who are young carers?

A young carer is someone **under 18** who helps look after someone in their family, or a friend, who is ill, disabled or misuses drugs or alcohol.

How many young carers are there?

- There are about **700,000 young carers in the UK**. (BBC 2010)*
- That's about **1 in 12 secondary aged pupils**.
- There are likely to be young carers in every school and college.

*The Census identified over 200,000 young carers, but many remain hidden.



Which one is the young carer?



Young carers are just young people – with caring responsibilities! They look the same as everyone else but they can lead very different lives!

Who do young carers care for?

Young carers care for someone:

- With an illness or disability.
- With a mental health condition.
- Who misuses drugs or alcohol.

Being a young carer can have a big impact on the things that are important to growing up

- It can affect a young person's health, social life and self-confidence.
- Many young carers struggle to juggle their education and caring which can cause pressure and stress.
- In a survey, 39% said that nobody in their school was aware of their caring role.
- 26% have been bullied at school because of their caring role.
- 1 in 20 miss school because of their caring role.

But young people can learn lots of useful skills by being a young carer.

What might a young carer do?

- Practical tasks, such as cooking, housework and shopping.
- Physical care, such as helping someone out of bed.
- Emotional support, such as talking to someone who is distressed.
- Personal care, such as helping someone dress.
- Managing the family budget and collecting prescriptions.
- Helping to give medicine.
- Helping someone communicate.
- Looking after brothers and sisters.
