

School Uniform – September 2016

At Hanwell, we are driven by high expectations and part of this is taking pride in our appearance and the expectation that our pupils will be appropriately dressed to learn. The school uniform is important to allow children to feel a sense of belonging to the school and to be reminded each morning when get up that there is a sense of purpose for the day.

The uniform can be purchased from Sewsublime. The only item we ask to have the school logo on is the jumper/cardigan. All other uniform can be purchased without the logo and sort from your own sources if so wished.

Children can wear:

Blue Hanwell jumper/cardigan

Yellow polo shirt

Black/Grey/Navy trousers or shorts

Black, navy or grey skirts/pinafore or

Summer Gingham dress allowed

(blue or yellow)

Flat plain black shoes – limited detail

Optional Wear – Hanwell Logo fleece

Year 6-

These pupils can wear a light blue polo shirt to be identified as Year 6.

PE Kit-

The PE Kit required is plain white t-shirt, black or navy jogging bottoms/shorts and plimsolls or training shoes to be used for indoor and outdoor. We ask that your child brings their PE Kit in every Monday morning and leaves it at school until Friday. This needs to be a white tee-shirt and black shorts.

Forest Schools-

If your child is attending forest school then they will need to bring old comfortable clothing that can get muddy. Please bring in forest school clothing as your child will be expected to change for their session.
