After School Clubs

Hanwell Fields runs a broad range of after school clubs both sporting and creative. The selection of clubs varies across the seasons and re designed to cover all age groups from year 1 to year 6. There is a correlation between some of the clubs available and the competitions run by NOSSP*. This provides an opportunity for children who want to enter the competition to practice and work with potential team mates. Clubs that have been run in 2017/18 so far include: Tag rugby, hockey, football, netball, cross country, sports hall athletics, table tennis, indoor games. In the summer term these will extend to athletics, tennis, cricket and rounders.

We also run a club for gifted and talented sportsmen and women. This is called Sports Academy and is aimed at those children who are very good at sport or who are very enthusiastic and who would benefit from additional coaching. This is the pool of talent generally used to create the teams for the school although this is not exclusive.

Creative clubs are also run and this year these have included: Change 4 Life, art, war hammer, creative writing, reading, book club, maths, computer building, cookery, homework and gardening. These again are available across the age ranges in the school. This portfolio gives 150 children access to an after school club place each week. They are extremely popular and most clubs are full to capacity. This year we have had to introduce a charge of £5 per term for each club attended. This covers the cost of staffing and materials for clubs. Children who receive Pupil Premium funding are exempt from this charge.
