<i>Spellings</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Continue to choose 2 – 3 words (per day) from the common exception word sheet (at the back of the home learning book) to practise reading and spelling. Look at which part is tricky (e.g. your – the tricky part is 'our').</li><li>- Watch, and join in with, the Set 3 speed sound lesson on Ruth Miskin Training every day (it is streamed live on youtube / facebook at 10.30am)</li></ul>
<i>Reading</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>-</li><li>- <b>Practise reading the sounds.</b> Use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', 'Say The Word'. Choose 2 – 3 sounds per day. Can you find them in your reading books?</li><li>- Access <a href="https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/PicnicOnPluto.html">https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/PicnicOnPluto.html</a> and choose 'phase 4'.</li><li>- Record 3x facts from your non-fiction library book that you found interesting</li><li>- Read your home reading books (x3 home reading books and 3 RWI books sent home). Try to spend 10 – 15 minutes reading per day. Write a review in your home learning book for one of the books you have read.</li></ul>
<i>Maths</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Please access mathletics to complete the activities we have set</li><li>- Record facts and draw pictures in your home learning book to show doubles up to double 6. Record them as a number sentence (e.g. <math>2 + 2 = 4</math>)</li><li>- Record related facts about bonds to ten e.g. <math>1 + 9 = 10</math>, <math>9 + 1 = 10</math>, <math>10 - 1 = 9</math>, <math>10 - 9 = 1</math></li><li>- Continue to watch youtube videos for skip counting in 2, 5, and 10. Use your home learning book to record the numbers you count. What patterns can you see?</li></ul>
<i>English</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Please continue to access <a href="https://www.roythezebra.com/reading-games/full-stop-1.html">https://www.roythezebra.com/reading-games/full-stop-1.html</a> (can be played on the computer or tablet) to punctuate the sentences with full stops. (search for Roy the Zebra full stops game)</li><li>- Please continue to access <a href="https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zd63xyc/articles/zncgvk7">https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/topics/zd63xyc/articles/zncgvk7</a> (can be played on the computer or tablet) to play the 'sentences' and 'punctuation' games. (search for BBC bitesize small town superheroes)</li><li>- Write about your day, in order, using language such as 'first, next, after that'.</li></ul>
<i>Extended writing:</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- In your home learning book, write a story about a dinosaur. Follow the steps of 'beginning, problem, fix it, ending'. "A long time ago, in a land far, far away....."</li></ul>
