Spellings	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- List as many words with the :- 'n' sound that are spelt with a 'kn' e.g. knight, knot. Check spelling in dictionary.- 'r' sound that are spelt with 'wr' e.g. wreck, wrong. Check spelling in dictionary. - Choose 3 of your words from each sound and write their definitions. - Choose 3 words from each sound and use them in a sentence. Write 3 sentences for 3 'kn' words and 3 sentences for 'wr' words. <p>Practise Jumping Orange words</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Accident, accidentally, arrive, appear, bicycle, build, business, breathe, breath, calendar, consider, decide, library.
Reading	<p>You can watch: Storytime with David Walliams: free story everyday at 11am on his website www.worldofdavidwalliams.com</p> <p>You have brought home x3 books.</p> <p>Set aside time to read for at least 30 minutes daily.</p> <p>Read your library books/ a big 6 book/ your home reader or any other book:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Write a review of it.• Choose a character from a book. In your home study books – create a grid with two columns. Label one column 'Likes' and the other column 'Dislikes'. Fill in columns with information that you know your character likes and dislikes. Choose 3 points and explain how you know this.• Create a new front cover for one the books you have read. Remember to make it different to the actual book.• Write an alternate ending to one of the books you have read.• Create a fact file about one of the authors.

English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Create a spooky setting and draw it e.g. it might be a haunted house or empty forest. You can use shading or colours – it is totally up to you. Once drawn, write a setting description for it. - Write an instruction text for something you have done this week or made at home this week. Remember to include imperative verbs, adverbs and adjectives and bullet points or numbers. You can also include drawings to show the steps. - Write a diary entry- this can be about anything you would like to write about. Make sure you write in first person, in the past, written in chronological (time) order and is descriptive. - Newspaper report- use your imagination to create a newspaper report about a hero saving the day. Remember to write in past tense, formal language, MOST important information first and to include a quote from someone involved in your story.
