

Topic overview.

This term our topic is 'The Tudors'. It will start with a visit to Sulgrave Manor in Northamptonshire. We will learn about Tudor childhood, clothing, behaviour, food and pastimes in particular. We will then study how Henry Tudor wrested power from Richard the Third and look at the succession of rulers until the dynasty ended with Elizabeth the First. We will consider the qualities showed by Henry the Eighth and why he married so many times. We will look at portraits of Tudor Royalty and the work of court painter Hans Holbein. We hope to produce our own Holbein-style portraits of a royal personage, in frames designed and made by us.
