


The Oxford Canal

Topic overview.

This term our topic is 'Canals'. We will look at the network of canals across England, when and why it was created. We will investigate how people lived on the canals and what work they did. One of our texts for the term will be a story about a working canal horse; 'Snowy' by Berlie Docherty. In art, we will study and try to imitate the jollity of canal art, using bright primary colour backgrounds overlaid by designs typically found in canal homewares



Subject coverage:

Literacy	Explanation texts and non-chronological reports.
Maths	Pictograms and bar charts, angles, properties of three dimensional shapes and symmetry.
Science	Light and shadow, movement of the sun and changes in shadow length.
Topic and Art	Canals; their origins, locations, uses and how people lived on them. How locks work. Canal art – decoration of everyday objects.
