Take a closer look...

Subject Coverage

English	The two focuses for this term will be instruction writing and stories from other cultures. The children will be exploring the story of Rama and Sita, discussing the characters and settings and then creating their own version. They will also write instructional texts.
Maths	The children will be developing an understanding of 2D/3D shapes and ordinal numbers (i.e. first, second, third) as well as chronological sequencing.
Science	We will be studying and recording the weather and investigating seasonal changes throughout the year.
History/ Geography	In Geography this term we will be investigating India and cultural differences. We will look at where India is in the world, compare typical school days and explore clothes and foods.
Computing	Children will learn why it is important to keep safe online, how to search online safely and why it is important to keep your personal details private
D and T	The children will develop their understanding of hygiene and make/cook basic Indian breads.
Art	We will study and create our own Rangoli and Mendhi patterns based on traditional methods.
Music	The children will be singing traditional Christmas carols in preparation for Christingle. We will also make short compositions.
R.E.	R.E this term will be based around the celebration of light, with particular focus on the festival and celebration of Diwali.
P.E.	This term the children will be focusing on indoor athletics techniques. This will include sprinting, hurdling, throwing and jumping skills.
SMSC	We will continue to follow the family links programme.
