Subject Coverage	
Literacy	The children will be reading Tyrannosaurus Drip this term. After exploring popular dinosaur stories we will create a large classroom display, appreciate dinosaur poems and write both class and individual dinosaur stories.
Maths	This term we will be learning about multiplication and division. Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as well as learning how to tell the time.
Science	The children will be identifying and naming a variety of dinosaurs which are herbivores, carnivores and omnivores.
History/ Geography	We will discover where dinosaurs lived, recording our findings on a world map. We will learn about when dinosaurs existed and when they became extinct and find out about the discovery that William Walker made.
Computing	Sorting and organising dinosaur data into different categories, creating tally charts and presenting data as a pictogram. Understanding that data can be in the form of an image, text, audio or video.
D and T	The children will create their own fossils using salt dough.
Art	The children will develop their observational drawing skills by studying a range of fossils and dinosaur bones.
Music	We will be using our voices expressively to sing some fantastic dinosaur themed songs for our video!
R.E.	Year 1 will be introduced to the special books of three major world religions. We will find out about the Torah, the Bible and the Qur'an and explore why they are important for Jews, Christians and Muslims.
P.E.	This term we will be having swimming lessons every Wednesday at Spiceball Leisure Centre.
