Create a fact-file about an Egyptian God (or create your own), include their name, their symbol and what they are responsible for/their role.	3	
Create and decorate a canopic jar.	2	
Create a news report (this could be written or recorded) telling the story of Howard Carters discovery of the tomb of Tutankhamun.	4	
Research and create a dial or poster to illustrate the three seasons of the Egyptian farming year.	2	
Create a pyramid. For an extra two points include a diagram showing the layout of the inside of the pyramid.	2	
Create a set of Top Trumps for the Gods of Egypt. Create at least 4 cards. Each card should have four categories (power, importance, likeability, popularity) and 100 points shared between these.	4	
Write a diary entry from the viewpoint of an Egyptian citizen, for example a slave, child, a Pharaoh or Queen.	3
