Please remember that we are not judging the final outcomes and that this homework is about the process that you go through to achieve the outcomes. Have fun, but please ask if we can help in anyway. We will also be setting maths or literacy homework each week.

Create a poster to encourage people to live in Hanwell Fields

(2 points)

This is Banbury in 1833

Create a family tree

(2 points)

Research a local landmark e.g. Banbury Cross, Fine Lady statue and write about it

(3 points)

Create your own timeline with either photos or drawings of you to show how you have changed

(3 points)

Draw or photograph 5 different features within Banbury

(3 points)

Visit the local museum to find out how Banbury has changed over the years. Record or write up the interview.

(2 points)

Make a board game linked to Hanwell Fields or Banbury in some way

(5 points)

Can you write the poem of the famous 'Fine Lady' in Banbury as a poster?

(2 points)

Paint, sketch or create a collage of the Fine Lady statue or Banbury Cross

(2 points)

Can you write maths word problems with a Banbury theme? E.g. I had 20 Banbury cakes and shared them between 4 friends. How many cakes did they get each?

(3 points)

Draw a map of your road and record all the features

(2 points)

Pretend you have gone back in time. Can you write a diary entry of what Banbury was like in the past?

(3 points)
