Our provision provides children with the opportunities to lead learning through play and develop understanding of their own next steps. We also celebrate the provision of our Forest School. Here pupils attend sessions to help develop their learning in an outside environment.

Hanwell Fields is built on the notion that we foster a love of learning. Through a whole school reward and behaviour policy, we recognise the importance of a consistent approach that celebrates and rewards all of our children.

We pride ourselves on providing rich and creative learning experiences.


We recognise the importance to not only embrace enthusiasm but to develop it through an innovative curriculum that allows children to flourish in all seven areas of learning.
