Upon the deeply sad news of the passing of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, we will be making some changes to our school day to mark this poignant yet historic moment in our lives.

Firstly, we have postponed the publication of our first newsletter of the year. We also do not feel it is appropriate to hold a celebration assembly today and will instead, hold special assemblies remembering the life of the Queen. The children will be invited to complete a piece of work on the Queen, which we will compile into a book of remembrance.

No matter what your personal views may be on the monarchy or Royal Family, Queen Elizabeth II has been a devout servant to this country for over 70 years, a constant in our lives, and we will pay her respect as such.

Obviously, her passing will raise with our pupils, the question of death and possibly emotions of sadness and grief, which some may find upsetting or sad.
