## Literacy

Look carefully at this picture and then complete the activities below.



1	<p>Look at the image – focus on your nouns and adjectives.  What things/objects can you see?  What describing words could you use? Write a few sentences including these words you've chosen.  <b>For example:</b> The dark, deep, blue sea. The never ending rickety staircase. The glowing of the wooden windows.</p>
2	<p>Today, you are going to explore what might be happening in the building.  What might be going on in the house?  Can you create a mind-map of your ideas – be really creative with the vocabulary you use to build up phrases.  <b>For example:</b> A mouse is nervously looking out of a window into the depths of the ocean.</p>

<b>3</b>	Write a list of questions you might like to ask about the picture. Think carefully about the questions – what would be your top three and why would you want to ask them? Remember to use a question mark at the end of your questions. (?)
<b>4</b>	Write a description about the mysterious fish. Create a list of adjectives you could use (be creative – we cannot fully see the fish so you can use your imagination). Use these to create sentences describing the size, colour, shape etc.
<b>5</b>	Today you are going to take on the role of the fisherman in the boat. Write a short diary entry about what he has seen, heard and been doing. Take some time before writing to plan out you ideas. Remember to use a capital letter for the pronoun 'I'.

The next days activities are based around the short film, 'Taking Flight'. Please watch this first by clicking the link or the picture, before you complete any of the activities.

<b>6</b>	Retell the story to an adult. What is the story about? What happens? Create a comic strip of what happens in the film.
<b>7</b>	Emotion: How is Tony feeling at different points in the film? How is Dad feeling when he sees Tony and Grandpa all dirty? What does Dad think about that changes his mood? <b>Can you create a timeline of how Dad and Tony are feeling throughout the film?</b>
<b>8</b>	Tony doesn't meet the aliens mentioned in the film... what do you think their conversation would've been if they did? <b>Have a go at writing a conversation that you think would have happened if they met. Challenge yourself to use other words for said.</b>
<b>9</b>	What could happen next in the story? Have a go at writing the next adventure Dad, Tony and Grandpa go on. It may help you to plan out your ideas first. <b>Remember to write in sentences with capital letters and full stops.</b>
<b>10</b>	Describe a journey you would really like to take. -What vehicle would you use? -Where would you go? -Who would you go with? -What would you see? <b>Answer these questions in full sentences to help you write a description of the journey.</b>
